

Finishes

A lot of research and testing has been done over the years to ensure we use some of the best coating products available. We believe the finishes we use in our manufacturing processes is one of the keys to our lifetime guarantee. Listed below are the finishes we use and some information about them.

- 2 pack finishes are our most durable and most common. For years we only used these finishes to ensure our quality. They are still our preferred coating system in many cases and stand up to decades of wear and tear. 2 pack coatings have the advantage of being able to be buffed when minor issues occur and generally need very little maintenance except a occasional routine clean or polish. 2 pack finishes are both clear lacquer and coloured paint and both can have a pearlescent effect added to them, with metallic also available in solid colours.
- Oil finishes are a coating system we use for specific styles of furniture, like recycled or distressed. The oil finish offers a coating more suitable to the style and design of the piece. Osmo oil is available world wide and its quality speaks for itself. It is a natural product and is very easy to care for with aftercare products available if required.
- Single pack products are a long way from there 2 pack alternatives and are only ever used if specifically requested. Although cheaper, the lower quality is certainly obvious. Single pack coatings are both clear and coloured. Regular cleaning is very important as the finish can be stained and effected quickly and easily. Products finished with single pack coatings are not covered by our lifetime guarantee and their use should always be considered carefully.
